Term 6 – Clubs – Reminder

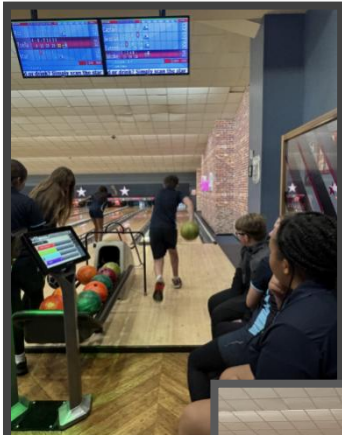
Please be aware that clubs will not run throughout Term 6. These will recommence in September. Further information will be shared towards the end of the academic year with information on sign-up for September.

Selected students in Year 9 will experience a workshop using interactive eye-witness testimony and virtual reality technology. They will be able to have a conversational experience with a Holocaust survivor and see the sites where the Holocaust took place, all without leaving the classroom. This workshop will take place during school hours on the school site and priority will be given to Year 9 students who have opted to study GCSE History as there are only 68 spaces available.
