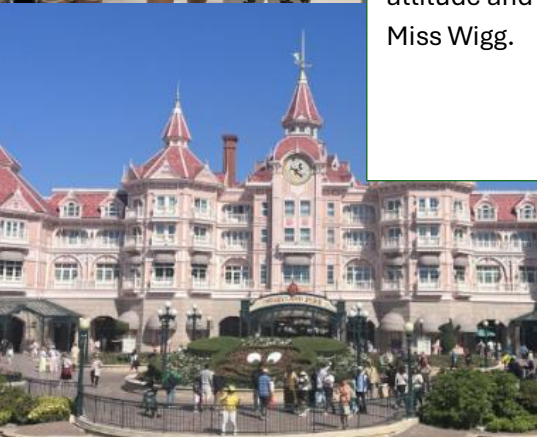


Rugby Tour – Paris 2026
