We have been visiting our temporary site regularly and are delighted with the incredible progress that has been made so far. The building has been transformed inside and out and will provide our founding cohort with the facilities to access the full and ambitious curriculum. We will have access to specialised science facilities, outdoor playing fields and drama and performance space. Our temporary home is in the centre of Ashford and is well-served by local transport services.

We are also excited by the progress made on our permanent site. You may have seen initial groundworks are taking place and we expect construction to commence over the coming months.

## Transition Day – Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June – 09:00am - 14:30pm.

All students joining us this coming September are invited to attend Chilmington Green School's Transition Day on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June. The day will be hosted at Wye School and will be an opportunity for students to be introduced to secondary school life. Students will enjoy a variety of activities throughout the day which will predominantly be delivered by Chilmington Green School staff.

Students should arrive for a 09:00 start and will be dismissed from the main school entrance at 14.30. Please ensure that travel arrangements have been made so that your child can safely travel to and from Wye School on the day. There will be an opportunity for parents/carers to purchase uniform from the pop-up shop at 14:30, further details of which can be found below.

For the transition days your child should wear their primary school uniform with shoes/trainers that will be suitable for outdoor activities. They will need to bring a bag containing drinks, a packed lunch, snacks and basic stationery (pen, pencil, ruler and rubber). Their bag should also contain any other items that you deem necessary, for example suntan lotion, waterproof, inhaler etc.

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Introducing the Chilmington Green School Community: Meet our Principal, Jon Rutland

We have now recruited all our teaching staff and, over the next few months, we will use our regular newsletters to introduce you to our teachers so that you can get to know them in advance of joining the school in September.

As Principal, I am first up and I am pleased to share with you my vision for Chilmington

Green School and set out how we are going to make the school a welcoming, nurturing and inclusive place which gives every student the opportunity to succeed.

I am passionate about the importance of education and strongly believe that an exceptional education can have a transformative impact on the life chances of young people. Establishing a new school in the area in which I grew up is an inspiring opportunity and I am committed to giving young people the excellent education which they are all entitled to.

### About Me

I grew up just a few miles from the Chilmington Green development and have lived in Ashford for much of my life. I started my teaching career at a school in Nottingham, teaching English and Geography. I then joined the Marsh Academy in New Romney, teaching English before becoming the Director of Learning for the department. I joined Wye School and United Learning in 2018, taking the role of Assistant Principal for Data and Outcomes before moving on to the role of Vice Principal for Teaching and Learning. These roles have enabled me to gain experience in a wide range of areas, including developing the quality of teaching and learning and overseeing the quality of pastoral care across the school. During this time, I have enjoyed significant professional development in preparation for the role of Principal at United Learning's Chilmington Green School.

#### My Vision for Chilmington Green School

Chilmington Green School will be a values-led school. In practice, this means we are seeking to instil character attributes that will allow students to flourish both within and beyond school. Our values of respect, determination and ambition will underpin our school community as a whole and will be explicitly taught through our curriculum. These values will support students in having high expectations of themselves, seeking opportunities to develop and being fully prepared to live successful and fulfilling lives.

What most excites me about being the school's first Principal is the opportunity to know each individual within our founding cohort. I hope that these 'small school' relationships between students and staff will be sustained as we grow through nurturing a close-knit community. Pastoral staff will be appointed to key roles to ensure that students achieve their potential in a supportive and nurturing environment.

Beyond this, academic success is of paramount importance. Our mission is to provide an exceptional education to all students irrespective of their starting point. Chilmington Green School will offer a fully inclusive and academic curriculum which seeks to prepare students for aspirational careers and further educational opportunities.

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I am determined that all students will benefit from a rich and varied extracurricular experience and we are working on an exciting programme which will give students opportunities to learn and develop beyond the classroom.

The school will be committed to our aim of operating at net-carbon zero and this will become part of our school culture, operational management and enrichment activities. Students, staff and the community will join together to minimise our collective carbon footprint and this environmental awareness will be a core part of our ethos and culture.

### My Commitment to Working with Parents

I greatly value the partnerships between parents/carers and the school and believe they are incredibly important in maximising children's chances of success. Our formative years are a unique opportunity for both students and families to shape the school for the needs of the community. As a school, we will be facilitating community engagement events in preparation for our opening and on an ongoing basis once the school is fully open. We will also be working with both families and other stakeholders to give the whole school community the opportunity to have a voice in how the school develops.

The countdown to opening is well underway and I am very much looking forward to welcoming our founding students in September!
