




Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to extend my thanks to the whole school community for what has been a thoroughly enjoyable first term at Chilmington Green School. The costs per term can be found below and are payable via Squid. If your child has been collecting a cooked lunch during term 1 and you would like this to continue, no action is required.
