#### Parent Survey

#### **School Values Points**

We place great emphasis on rewarding and celebrating positive behaviour and acknowledging students who embody our school values; these are Ambition, Determination and Respect. Students are rewarded through a points system used by all staff throughout the school day.

Staff give three points at the end of each lesson for students who have demonstrated the school values. In addition to this, students are also awarded points for their positive behaviour outside of lessons.

Points awarded can be seen on the Arbor Parent Portal and will be shared weekly with students during Friday lunchtime. School Values points will be used to determine the below rewards:

Silver Pin Badge	Awarded to the first 30 students to reach 100 points this academic year.

## **Home Learning**

Our compulsory home learning tasks in English, maths and French/Spanish has now begun. Teaching staff will be setting detentions from this point forward for students to catch up on any missing tasks.

### **Set Changes**

All students are placed into sets for English, maths, geography and science. Sets are initially created using data from the Year 6 SATS and information provided by primary schools. During the first half of this term, some students will be moved to be in sets most aligned with their ability. We will reset students twice annually; this will follow the mid-year assessments and the end of year assessments.
