Ski Trip 2025

We are excited to bring you details of our planned Ski Trip to Cesana Italy, April 2025 Sunday 6th April – Sunday 13th April), combined with Wye School. This is a week-long residential trip and will include the following:

- Travel by executive coach (with TV/DVD/WC) including all tolls and taxes
- Return Cross Channel Ferry

- Accommodation at Hotel Solaris
- Meals (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)
- Ski Lessons (x5 days)
- Ski Pass (x5 days)
- Ski Hire Equipment including helmet
- Winter Sports and Travel/Medical Insurance
- In House après ski programme (film night, quiz night etc)
- Piste Closure Insurance
- Ski Breakage Insurance

You will be required to provide your child's ski clothing (jacket, salopettes, underlayers, gloves). These can be hired or purchased from retailers/supermarkets.

Total Cost of inclusive ski trip is £1300 which will be broken down into 10 smaller instalments (however should you wish to make larger payments you can) with a securing deposit of £130 by Thursday 1st February.
