# Extra-Curricular Timings – Term 4

Throughout Term 4, many extra-curricular activities will revert back to a 16:30 finish. For activities at Ashford Oaks, these will finish at 16:40 (Rugby and Girls' Football). All Ashford School clubs continue as normal. Should there be a valid reason for your child to miss their assigned after school activity, please could parents/carers inform the school office before midday on the day the club takes place.

#### NGRT

We would like to inform you that the NGRT (New Group Reading Test) assessments are scheduled to take place after half term. The NGRT is a standardised, adaptive assessment designed to measure reading skills against the national average. It includes tasks such as sentence completion and reading comprehension and typically takes 30-50 minutes to complete.

We conduct this test three times per year to track the progress of your child's reading ability and, where needed, we implement targeted interventions to support your child's reading development. These tests will be sat during English lessons throughout the coming term.
