Our established external partner, Talk Consent, will be delivering an assembly for students in Year 7 during the coming term. The assembly is carefully tailored to align with students' developmental stages, ensuring all material is appropriate and presented in a relatable and sensitive manner. The team at Talk Consent aim to create an environment where students feel comfortable engaging, asking questions, and discussing these important topics.

During this assembly the focus is on helping students understand the importance of boundaries and empowering them to uphold their own. The meaning of consent is introduced in an age-appropriate way.
