

Dear Parents/Carers

This week, we have been delighted to welcome our new Year 6 students who joined on Monday and Tuesday for their transition day. It was a pleasure to welcome them into the school community and see them embrace the day with confidence and enthusiasm. New Catering Service from September

We are making some exciting changes to the school meal service from next year and our caterer, Taylor Shaw, are busy making preparations in our new kitchen. This will include a broader choice of food options during lunchtime service, as well as introducing breakfast and mid-morning break items. Please note that it will no longer be necessary to opt into school lunches on a termly basis - students can switch between school meals and packed lunches as preferred. We kindly ask that iPay accounts are topped up on a regular basis in order to ensure there are sufficient funds to cover any items purchased from the school canteen.

Sports day will be hosted on Monday 14th July for Year 7 and Tuesday 15th July for Year 8. All events will take place during periods 4 and 5. Children will be released from school as normal at 3.30.
