School Catering

If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, please be advised that the options available are Main Meal of the Day (Meat/Vegetarian) and Main Pudding of the Day. This is charged at £2.90 for non-FSM students. All other selections, including drinks, are not included and will need to have available funds on the iPay system. We have several drinking fountains available in school from which student can fill water bottles.

Pick-Up and Drop Off

Thank you to all families who have support the pick-up and drop off process this week. Could I please remind drivers of the below:

- The area adjacent to the sports hall is for drop-off only. Please could families use this space for dropping off only; should you wish to speak to a member of staff, or support your child into school, please use the parking bays. This will support the flow of traffic and maintain movement on site.
- Could all families please follow the one way system to minimize traffic backing up onto the roads.
- Should your child need to wait on site after 3.10, they are able to wait in the canteen area until 4.00 for the first half term. This is subject to change and any alteration to this will be communicated with families.
- There are several lay-bys available to parents/carers on the newly opened road into the school which you may wish to use for drop-off and collection if this is more convenient.
- Please avoid using the disabled bays unless you are a blue badge holder.
